**Ron Klasko Addresses University HR Directors
at National Public Policy Forum**

Philadelphia, PA April 18, 2008 - H. Ronald Klasko, the founding partner of the immigration law firm **Klasko, Rulon, Stock & Seltzer LLP**, recently spoke on “Trends in Immigration: Impact on Higher Education” at the College and University Professional Association for Human Resources’ Public Policy Forum in Washington D.C.
