**Ron Klasko Addresses Representatives of Universities and
Foreign Embassies in D.C.**

Philadelphia, PA March 3, 2008 - H. Ronald Klasko, the founding partner of the immigration law firm **Klasko, Rulon, Stock & Seltzer LLP**, recently addressed attendees at the Annual Washington International Education Conference on the immigration challenges universities face in attracting foreign students.
