In addition, he has been an Adjunct Professor of Immigration Law at Villanova University Law School and is a frequent lecturer on immigration law subjects.

Ron is the co-author of the two-volume *Employers' Immigration Compliance Guide* (Matthew Bender 1985). He is a graduate of the University of Pennsylvania Law School.
